MONTROSE WATER SPORTS PARK

This project represents a technological advance for REP designed whitewater parks. Using innovative construction techniques, REP created six, varied, white-water features and adjacent fish passages. The park turned a neglected stretch of the Uncompahgre River into a multi-use park with riverside trails, fish habitat improvements and bank access improvements. Montrose held its first annual whitewater festival in August 2015 and the park has become the premier white-water park in the region in the first season. Each uniquely designed feature creates whitewater suitable for the variety of crafts and users now regularly seeking out whitewater parks including; surfers, stand up paddleboards, kayaks, rafters and inner tubers.

This project represents a technological advance for REP designed whitewater parks.
